Monday, August 12th 2019

The following topics were discussed at the Meeting:

Prof. dr Snežana Smederevac and prof. dr Branko Milosavljević, team members of the Erasmus+ project BE-OPEN, presented the repository of the University of Novi Sad to Prof. dr Dejan Jakšić, rector, and to Prof. dr Stevan Stankovski, vice-rector for research.

The profile pages for the majority of researchers from faculties and institutes of the University of Novi Sad have been created and metadata on research output has been withdrawn from the SCOPUS database. Two faculties need to provide a list of their researchers: Faculty of Technical Sciences and Faculty of Economics.

One of the questions raised during the meeting was whether to include researchers working on projects funded from the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development and PhD students.

Rule book on Open Science for the University of Novi Sad will be presented to all members of the Senate in September. All faculties and institutes will have 15 days to name an administrator in charge for maintaining data on researchers at the institutions.

By the end of year, all Universities in Serbia will have repositories. Further meetings with the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development are planned in order to ensure funding for sustainability of repositories.
