Tuesday, 14 April 2020

University of Novi Sad, the coordinator of Erasmus+ Boosting Engagement of Serbian Universities in Open Science (BE-OPEN project), organized the Final Project Conference with all partner institutions on April 14th, 2020. It was planned that the Final Conference takes place at the University of Novi Sad, but due to the COVID- 19 pandemic, it was decided to organize the conference online.

Prof. dr Saša Lazović, Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development, welcomed the participants and emphasized three important points the Ministry is focused on in regards with Open Science: accessibility, accuracy and visibility of research outputs.

Prof. dr Stevan Stankovski, vice-rector for science at the University of Novi Sad, welcomed participants from partner institutions, emphasized the importance of the BEOPEN project results and achievements and thanked all partner institutions for the hard work in the past three and a half years.

Prof. dr Snezana Smederevac, UNS, coordinator of the BE-OPEN project, welcomed participants from partner institutions and thanked them for the successful work of all partners.

In the first session, prof. Smederevac presented the overall impact of the BEOPEN project on Open Science in Serbia. This was followed by presentations of each Serbian university on the results achieved.

Guest lecturers were invited for the second session.

Biljana Kosanović (on behalf of **Prof. dr. Vladimir Crnojević**, BioSense Institute) gave a presentation about the current status and future plans for Serbia in the European Open Science Cloud initiative.

Prof. dr. Miroslav Trajanović, University of Niš, presented the OpenClick project developed by researchers from the University of Niš.

Mirjana Utvić, center for the Promotion of Science, talked about Citizen Science in Serbia.
